Responsibilities (in your words):

What went well?

- The location of the SC committee was close to perfect – easy access to the WS committee in the volunteer centre
- Having the volunteer centre in a permanent structure was nice

What could have gone better?

- From a Chair standpoint, while the staff dining option is great, and generally the meals/snacks provided were delicious, there was a lot of bread/sanwiches and all but 2 of the 15 meals/snacks served during our 5 days onsite were cold. Warm meals daily were available from the same caterer at the RBCCO – they were very much appreciated during the 12+ hour days.
- Lighting from the shuttle drop off to the volunteer centre is important – we arrived before sunrise, and many days left after sunset

Suggestions for future events (this can be for your committee specifically or the event as a whole):

- Please continue to locate the SC committee as close as possible to the WS committee – SC is really a sub-committee of the WS committee
- No Chair roles are needed for the SC committee – this can be managed with the same Chair(s) as the WS committee
- Try not to overstaff the SC committee – we were not able to offer as many shifts as was noted as a requirement (only 3 instead of the minimum 4) due to the amazing number of volunteers we had.

What do you wish you would have known prior to tournament week? Is there anything that Golf Canada could have done to better prepare you for the tournament?

- I have nothing to add here, having volunteered/Chaired with the RBCCO for many years – preparation is well-engrained
