Committee: Medical Committee

Responsibilities (in your words):

The Medical Committee is responsible for delivering medical services to players, caddies, and their families throughout tournament week. To support these services, a designated private examination area should be equipped with curtains, an examination table, and essential medical supplies including medical examination gloves, masks and first aid supplies.

Medical Chairs are tasked with recruiting licensed medical professionals to staff the medical area during the tournament. They also oversee the committee's operations to ensure consistent and comprehensive medical coverage for all players, caddies, and their families.

What went well?

PRE EVENT

- 1. Neither of our co- chairs were licensed physicians which worked just fine for us
- 2. Our mandate all along was to provide care to players, caddies and their immediate family. Their was a request to change close to the event that was not well received
- 3. Location in the yoga studio of the gym and provided for a good amount of privacy
- 4. Meet and greet with committee members in advance of tournament

DURING THE EVENT

- 1. Emphasize to next years committee the help, support and knowledge of the 2 LPGA physios. Encourage them to share a space and work collaboratively to make our days easier
- 2. Majority of incidents were minor and simple to handle
- 3. Our volunteers covered the medical spectrum of Drs., Nurses, Chiropractor and Paramedic which worked just fine

What could have gone better?

PRE EVENT

- 1. Highly recommend communicate with previous chairs
- 2. For whatever reason we had poor buy in from MGCC members on this committee
- 3. Timely knowledge as to whom the EMS service was and a clear account of what supplies they were bringing

What could have gone better? DURING EVENT

- 1. Only require 2 volunteers per shift. Suggest 1 co-chair and 1 medical professional
- 2. Shifts from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm
- 3. Knowledge that if a player withdraws from the event the LPGA may ask/require a Dr. note



4. Having on hand small individual samples of medications such as Tylenol, Advil, lotion and creams.

Suggestions for future events (this can be for your committee specifically or the event as a whole):

Clearer direction of the required first aid supplies

What do you wish you would have known prior to tournament week? Is there anything that Golf Canada could have done to better prepare you for the tournament?

Understanding of the role of the LPGA Physio team in advance

What is your favorite memory from the CPKC Women's Open?
