Responsibilities (in your words):

What went well?

What could have gone better?

A more clear description/timeline of the actual tasks that needed to be performed.

Week of tournament: Having 3 committee volunteers on site for 7 days, 4 hour shifts was a waste of time. I worked the 4 tournament days and only had 1 task assigned which took me only 15 minutes to complete, by myself.

Post Tournament Week: Tasks were easily identified and volunteers were kept busy so all good here.

Suggestions for future events (this can be for your committee specifically or the event as a whole):

Committee specific: Need to stress physical requirements of tasks. Volunteers should be prepared for bending, lifting, carrying. Being physically fit is a must.

No need for volunteers on Tournament Week. From what I could see the 5 co-op interns could deal with any issues that arise. This way Committee volunteers could do a day or two volunteering for a different committee during Tournament week.

What do you wish you would have known prior to tournament week? Is there anything that Golf Canada could have done to better prepare you for the tournament?

Knowing the actual limited tasks for Volunteers during the Tournament week would have helped me in assigning Volunteers to work that week. No point in have someone drive from out of town for a 4 hour shift in which they did nothing but be on call.
