Committee Job Description

From Wednesday through Sunday, the Golf Canada Foundation will be selling 50/50 tickets on-site at the CPKC Women's Open. Volunteers are needed to assist in selling tickets. During their shift, each volunteer will be given a Golf Canada Foundation caddy bib with a 50/50 name badge on the back. Volunteers will be assigned to specific areas of the course to sell tickets.

Volunteers must be comfortable actively approaching people (outgoing personalities encouraged) and comfortable walking and standing for long periods of time. A handheld terminal will be used to sell tickets. No cash is accepted, all sales are made with debit or credit cards. Training on the use of the terminals is provided prior to the tournament.



Key Information

- While tickets will be sold over the course of 5 days, there will only be ONE 50/50 draw, which will take place Sunday evening.
- The winning number will be available online and, if possible, the winner will be contacted directly by the Golf Canada Foundation.
- Proceeds from the raffle will benefit junior golf initiatives and help to grow the game in the host province, host city, and across the nation.
- Your volunteer headquarters for 50/50 will be in the Volunteer Centre. The Golf Canada Foundation Staff assist this committee and will provide training on the POS terminal.

Tasks and Timelines

Pre-Tournament	• Actively recruit volunteers • Attend Committee Chair Meetings • Connect with Golf Canada and the Golf Canada Foundation to ensure roles and responsibilities are understood. • Work on volunteer schedule and assign volunteers to shifts in the Trust Event Volunteer Management System. • Attend the general volunteer orientation.
Tournament Week	• Work with the Golf Canada Foundation staff to ensure successful 50/50 sales. This includes training all volunteers on the 50/50 sales POS machines. • Lead and Manage the 30 volunteers across the 5 days of selling tickets. • Act as an on-site supervisor to the volunteers and help with any last-minute training on the 50/50 ticket system. • Coordinate replacements, or act as a replacement for any volunteers that cannot attend a shift.
Post Tournament	• Complete post-event committee chair feedback report.



Supplies

- 50/50 bibs
- POS terminals
- 50/50 paddles
- Rolls of paper (for replacing in POS terminal)
- Stickers to denote who has purchased a ticket

Other committees 50/50 Sales may interact with	Reason
Ambassadors	Ambassadors are stationed in high traffic areas, which are ideal for 50/50 sales. These areas may change throughout the tournament and engaging with the ambassadors will provide insight into good sales areas.
Corporate Hospitality	Generally, 50/50 volunteers are allowed to enter the hospitality areas once per day to sell tickets to guests.
